Competitive Games (Webelo's Recruiting) & Wilderness Survival MB

Where: This campout will be held at Illini State Park near Marseilles, IL about 54 miles from Naperville.

What: Competitive Games (Capture the Flag, Football, etc.....with Webelo's Recruiting) Campout for all Scouts. Wilderness Survival Merit Badge work for those older Scouts that wish to pursue this Merit Badge. Please note that this MB is required to be completed before participating in any High Adventure Outing (Philmont, Seabase, Northern Tier, etc) under Troop 510 policy. Work on this MB will also take place during the Troop Meetings on Oct 21st, Oct 28th and Nov 4th

When: Arrive at St. Raphael's Church at 6:00 PM for a prompt 6:30 PM departure on Friday November 6th. **DO NOT DRIVE DIRECTLY TO THE CAMPSITE--YOU MUST CHECK IN AT THE CHURCH!** Return: Sunday, Nov 8th late morning.

Costs: There is a \$30 fee per Scout & a \$15 fee per Adult payable to BSA Troop 510. If you turn in the signed forms and payment by Wednesday, October 21, 2009, you may take a \$5 per person early bird discount. To allow for adequate planning, no sign ups will be taken after the Troop Meeting on October 28th.

Other Important Information:

- + This cost includes transportation, camping fees, Saturday dinner and Sunday breakfast. Scout Patrols will need to grub for Friday night cracker barrel, Saturday breakfast and Saturday lunch at additional costs as determined by patrol.
- + If you as a parent wish to attend and/or drive, you must have completed the BSA background (reference) check, the BSA Youth Protection Training, & the Catholic Church's Protecting God's Children.
- + **Prescription & Non-Prescription Medications:** It is Troop 510's policy that no medication may be in the possession of any Scout during a Troop 510 outing. Any and all medications must be turned in to the outing's adult leader(s). As per the BSA Guide to Safe Scouting, the taking of the medication is the responsibility of the Scout taking the medication and/or that individual's parent/guardian and will therefore be distributed to the Scout upon request by the Scout. It is highly recommended that written guidelines for the taking of such medications be provided to the Outing Coordinator by the Scout's parent/guardian. Any discrepancy between a Scout's request for medications and the written guidelines will be immediately communicated to the Parent/Guardian via telephone.
- + No electronic devices are allowed to be in the possession of Scouts on Troop 510 campouts. This includes, but is not limited to: cell phones, game devices, etc. Any such items will be collected and returned to the Scout's parent/guardian.
- + Adult drivers will be determined by the Outing Coordinator to minimize transportation costs, will be reimbursed according to Troop 510 policy and will have final determination regarding passengers in their vehicle.
- + This is a tenting campout and the weather is unpredictable, so dress and gear up accordingly. **Rain gear is always required.** Per insurance specifications and to promote Scout unity, the khaki uniform (Class A) shirt must be worn to and from all Troop 510 activities.
